



DAILY UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Elementary School, Grade 3

Overview - What to Wear & When!

- **Dress Uniform** = only as communicated by teachers in accordance with special days.
- **Non-Dress Uniform** = every day (unless otherwise directed).
- **Physical Education** = children will not change for PE at the start of the year. However, starting in January, children will begin to practice changing at school as teachers work to build students' independence in preparation for Grade 4.
- **Spirit Gear** = may be worn in place of the non-dress uniform on Friday.

**These are the general daily guidelines.*

**In the event of distance learning, students are not required to be in uniform.*

**Communications on periodic changes may come via the Principal, Homeroom Teacher, or Class Parent.*

Detailed Uniform Description

Dress Uniform

- Girls: White Dress Shirt, Kilt (or option for navy dress pant), Navy Tights or Navy Socks
- Boys: White Dress Shirt, Navy Dress Pant, Navy or Black Socks, Blackwatch clip-on tie
- All children must have black shoes, with a flat heel, and non-marking soles

Non-Dress Uniform

- Girls: Kilt, Skort or Navy Sweatpants, Blue Polo (available in both short and long sleeve), Zipped Hoodie (*optional*), Navy Tights or Socks, sneakers with a non-marking sole
- Boys: Navy Sweatpants, Blue Polo (available in both short and long sleeve), Zipped Hoodie (*optional*), Navy Socks, sneakers with a non-marking sole

Phys Ed (required after Christmas)

- Red Cotton T-shirt
- Navy Sweatpants or Navy Shorts (girl and boy lengths available)
- Sneakers with non-marking soles

Recess Clothing

- Parents are asked to ensure children have proper outdoor clothing available and present at the school to suit seasonal requirements (i.e. raincoat, snow pants, boots in winter, etc.)
- Outdoor footwear must be different than indoor shoes (ie. not PE sneakers or dress shoes)

Spirit Gear

- Any Sacred Heart branded piece of clothing. Current or discontinued Sacred Heart clothing is also acceptable.

- Spirit Gear may be ordered from the online school shop

Shoes

- Shoes are not sold by the School Shop. Parents are asked to source footwear.
